

MRS WALTER LOMBARD DIES AT ARLINGTON

ARLINGTON, Sept 10—Mrs Nellie Florence Lombard, nee Snow, wife of Maj Gen Walter E. Lombard, died early today after a long sickness. She was 75 years old.

Funeral services will be held at her late home, 70 Kensington pk, at 2:30 p m Saturday.

Mrs Lombard was born in Randolph on July 19, 1861. She lived in Cambridge from her infancy until 1897 when she moved to Arlington. Last July she observed her 56th wedding anniversary. She was an

honorary member of Corp William P. Kenibbs Camp 66, U. S. W. V. of Arlington, and a member of its Auxiliary.

She leaves a husband, a son, Nathan C. Lombard, and a daughter, Mrs George L. Hull.
