

## Mrs. Addie Lombard

Mrs. Addie A. Lombard, 98, of 373 Lincoln Ave., widow of Benjamin F. Lombard, died at a local convalescent home today.

A native of Newfields, Maine, she was born Dec. 31, 1859, the daughter of the late Rev. John A. and Julia A. (Nealey) Rogers, and had resided in Biddeford before coming to Portsmouth more than 70 years ago.

Mrs. Lombard had been active in the Christian Scientist Church all of her life and was a member of the First Church of Christ Scientist in Portsmouth and the Mother Church of Boston.

She was believed to have been one of the oldest living Christian Science practitioners in the church, having practiced for nearly 50 years.

Mrs. Lombard was a milliner in Portsmouth for 21 years.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. Willard Howe of Portsmouth, and several nieces and nephews.
