First Eisenhower appointee to be sworn in New York State, J. Edward Lumbard Jr., graduate of Harvard College and Harvard Law School, took office yesterday as new U. S. Attorney for the Southern District, succeeding Myles Lane. The 51-year-old Lumbard took the oath

from Senior Federal Judge John C. Knox in the latter's chambers in the Federal Building. As part of the new oath, he swore that he was not a member of the Communist or Fascist parties, or any organization advocating overthrow of the government.
