Mrs. Shirley C. Lombard, 74, teacher, poet, drama instructor and government worker, died Monday at her home in Kamuela, Hawaii.

Graveside services will be held at 2 p.m. Monday in Hawaiian Memorial Park.

Her career in Hawaii included employment with Queen's Hospital, city Department of Parks and Recreation, Kokokahi YWCA and Army Special Services at the R and R Center at Fort DeRussy as well as teaching at Roosevelt and Leilehua High schools.

A volume of her Haiku poetry about Hawaii was published by Topgallant Publishing Co.

She was active in promoting theater for teen-agers while a parks and recreation employee.

Also, she was active in the Baha'i Faith, editing the "Light of the Pacific," a Baha'i newsletter with worldwide distribution.

Survivors include two sisters, Mrs. Elizabeth Stewart of Reno, Nev., and Mrs. Jean Krauss of Haiku, Maui.
