

Meanwhile, coastguardsmen are continuing a lake surface check for bodies of three Tiffin people who have been missing since a boating accident last Saturday. Still missing are Mr. and Mrs. Sylvester Wagner and Richard Weatherall, 20. Rescued after clinging to a life jacket was Miss Frances Wagner, 17, daughter of the Wagner couple and fiance of Weatherall.

Officers at the Marblehead Coast Guard station feel almost certain that the bodies of the three Tiffinites have gone out into the lake and have been swept toward Cleveland.

That accident happened while the fishing party was attempting to return to shore. A wave swamped their boat and threw the occupants into the lake off the Marblehead light. A dog owned by the Wagners also drowned in the mishap and was found Saturday afternoon.
