

## Floyd Lumbarb Dies at Home of Parents

Former Secretary to State Insurance  
Commissioner Passes  
Away.

Floyd Lumbarb 37 years of age, son of Mr and Mrs Giles B Lumbarb of 496 South Second street, passed away in this city yesterday morning after an illness which has kept him from work for the past year. Funeral services will be held at the Lumbarb residence at 10 30 o'clock Tuesday morning and will be conducted by the Rev George I Long, pastor of the Second Presbyterian church. The remains will be cremated at Mount Olivet cemetery.

Floyd Lumbarb was born in Iowa City, Iowa, March 2, 1880. About 20 years ago he came to San Jose with his parents, and after attending the San Jose high school for a time, he went through business college and was soon appointed private secretary to Byron D Wolfe, state insurance commissioner with offices in San Francisco. Mr Lumbarb remained in the state insurance office until a year ago when his health broke down and he came to San Jose and made his home with his parents on South Second street. He was a member of the San Jose lodge of B P O Elks and had a wide circle of friends in this city. Friends and acquaintances are invited to attend the funeral services.

The decedent leaves to mourn his passing a widow, Mrs Floyd Lumbarb, his father and mother Mr and Mrs Giles B. Lumbarb, and two brothers Glenn H. and Clarence Lumbarb.
