

**Mrs. Elizabeth Lombard**

Mrs. Elizabeth Lombard, a former Portage county resident, and mother of Henry Lombard of McDill, died Sunday night at 10 o'clock at her Wausau home, following an illness of three weeks. Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the home and the body was placed in a mausoleum in Pine Grove cemetery.

Mrs. Lombard, whose maiden name was Elizabeth Goldsmith, was born in Hamburg, Germany, June 6, 1851 and came to this country with relatives at the age of six. The family settled in Portage county where she was married in 1869 to Washington Lombard, who preceded her in death a number of years ago. She was a resident of Wausau for the past 34 years.
