Mrs. Henry Lombard

Mrs. Henry Lombard, 47, died Monday afternoon at 1.30 o'clock at her home at McDill. She had been in ill health for the past year and a half. Her condition became worse several weeks ago and for the past month she was confined to bed.

Mrs. Lombard, whose maiden name was Mable Ross, was born at McDill on January 31, 1890, a daughter of the late Aaron and Anna Ross. Attending school at McDill, she lived there until her marriage to Mr. Lombard of Wausau which took place on October 26, 1912, at McDill.
