
Wakefield Private Killed in Italy

WAKEFIELD, Nov. 3—Mr. and Mrs. Perley W. Lombard of 13 Greenwood st., have received a telegram from the War Department stating their son, Pfc Perley W. Lombard Jr., 20, infantryman, was killed in action in Italy, where he was serving with the 5th Army. He would have been in the service two years next February.

Pfc Lombard, a graduate of Wakefield High School, had been overseas for one year. A brother, Sgt Maynard L. Lombard, has not been heard from since he arrived in England four days before the invasion of France.
