FROZES TO DEATH. — The body of Euch L. Flood was found in a timber shed at Noble's Island on Saturday afternoon last. He had been missing since Friday January 10th. Flood was a shoemaker by trade, and was once in good circumstances, residing in a house which he owned near the powder house on Istington road; but having acquired a taste for intozicating drinks, had fallen rapidly during the past few years. He was apparently between forty and fifty years of age.

In his pockets were found (wo bottles,—emp:y but retaining a strong odor of rum. three short tobacco pipes, a memorandum book, a pocket book containing a few cents, and one or two other articles.
