

Mrs. H. S. Lombard passed out of this life at 11 o'clock, p. m. Tuesday, January 24, 1911. She was born in the state of Maine in the month of April, 1837. On November 29th, 1855, she was married to H. S. Lombard. The couple moved to Cass co. Nebraska, in April 1866 and continued to live there until their removal to this county in the year 1893. The husband and two daughters, Mrs. Fannie Foulk and Mrs. Lillie F. Welch survive the wife and mother.

Mrs. Lombard united with the Congregational church in 1874 and lived a consistent christian life for thirty seven years. Her married life extended over forty five years and during these years she was happy with husband and daughters. In late years of her life sickness clouded her life and the lives of those near and dear to her, but in all her afflictions she had their care and attention, their love and noble efforts to make her as contented and comfortable as was possible.

The funeral took place at 2 p.m. Thursday, from the Baptist church, Rev. A. B. Kirk having it in charge. Many friends were present at this service and thus showed their sympathy and respect for the deceased and the sorrowing relatives. The interment was at Forest Park cemetery.
