AT ADVANCED AGE

MRS. ANN LOMBARD ANSWERS
FINAL SUMMONS.

Had Been a Resident of Lapeer Coun-
ty For More Than Half
a Century.

Lapeer, Mich., Oct. 10.—Mrs. Ann Lombard, one of the old residents of this county, passed away yesterday at her home on Mill street after an illness of several months. Mrs. Lombard was 94 years old and until last March was as active as a woman of half her age. She had been confined to her bed since that time and suffered a great deal, but her patience and fortitude were remarkable. By her kind disposition she won many friends who will be grieved to her of her death. Mrs. Lombard was born in Saratoga Springs, N. Y., her maiden name being Ann Andrus. She was the youngest and only surviving member of a family of nine children. Her early life was spent at her home in New York, whence she received her education and in young womanhood was united in marriage to Isaac V. Conklin, of New York. Ten years later Mrs. Conklin was united in marriage to Albert Lombard, of Lapeer, who died thirty years ago. Since her husband's death Mrs. Lombard had spent most of her time at Oregon and Lapeer. Besides her daughter, she leaves five step children—George Lombard, of Kingston; Charles Lombard, of Lapeer; Henry Lombard, of Waters; Mrs. Mary Slafker, of Tuscola county; and Mrs. Cornelia Goodenough, of St. Louis, Mich. Mrs. Lombard was a member of the Methodist Episcopal church of Lapeer and was an earnest worker until incapacitated by age. The funeral will be held on Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. C. H. Whitney officiating. The remains will be laid to rest in Mount Hope cemetery.
