

Judge Horton granted a divorce to Mrs. Amelia Passapae from Harvey Passapae. Both are opera singers, the defendant being now connected with the Sanger opera company. They were married at Baltimore in 1881, and he deserted her in 1888 and married Mrs. Anna W. Chester of St. Albans, Vt. Mrs. Passapae charged him with bigamy, and stated that she made Chicago her headquarters, her husband's residence being Baltimore. Judge Horton was at first disposed to hold that her residence followed that of her husband, but after looking up the law he decided that she having been deserted by her husband that interfered with the rule of a wife's domicile following that of her husband. The court decided therefore that she was entitled to a divorce.
