

## WAUKESHA COUNTY PIONEER.

Death of John Graham, Who Lived  
for Many Years at Delafield.

Milwaukee, Wis., October 14, 1899.—  
John Graham, who was for many years  
a resident of Waukesha county, where he  
served as sheriff, died in this city  
today. Mr. Graham was about 65  
years of age and was married to a sister  
of Judge Mallory. His wife died some  
years ago.

Mr. Graham was very well known to  
all old residents of Waukesha county.  
He lived in the town of Delafield for a  
long time, but after his election as sheriff  
he removed to the village of Waukesha.  
There he remained until some years ago,  
when he gave up farming and be-  
came a traveling man. Mr. Graham  
was born in Toronto, Canada, but came  
to the United States in early life. He  
was still a resident of Waukesha county  
at the time of his death, but was a  
frequent visitor to Milwaukee and was  
well-known here. Some time ago, find-  
ing his health failing, he came to the  
city for treatment and rented the rooms  
on Jackson street, where he died.
