

## Tuesday Date Fixed For Wilcox Funeral

TURLOCK, Oct. 10. — Funeral services will be conducted to-morrow afternoon at 2 o'clock at the chapel of the Geckler Funeral Home for Mrs. Emily Vernon Wilcox, 75, who died at the home of a son, W. W. Wilcox, at Denver last Friday. The Rev. D. L. Moffett, pastor of the Presbyterian church, and Rev. D. H. McCullagh will officiate. Burial will follow in the Turlock cemetery.

Mrs. Wilcox was a native of Ohio, where she remained until 1873, when she moved to Osborne county, Kansas. In 1908 she located in Geckler, Idaho, and remained there until 1919, when she came with her husband to make her residence at 1235 East Main street, Turlock, where she has since lived. Mrs. Wilcox was a member of the Presbyterian church.

Besides the husband, Edward D. Wilcox, two sons survive, W. W. Wilcox of Denver and R. V. Wilcox of Turlock, and four grandchildren and three great grandchildren.
