Daughter of the Late Capt. Marshall Kills Herself.

DAYTON SWINDLER CAPTURED.

Reform School Boys Escape and Steal Two Horses—Great Northern Brake- man Run Over in Moses Coulee.

PORTLAND, Oct. 30.—Mrs. C. A. Lombard, wife of a prominent young broker, committed suicide in her room at "The Hill," a family hotel, this evening by shooting herself with a pistol. The couple had only been married a few months, but it is said they did not live happily together.

The suicide has created a profound sensation, as they were very prominent in society. Mrs. Lombard was a daughter of Capt. James Marshall, of Seattle, who committed suicide about a year ago by leaping into the Pacific ocean from a steamer while off the Oregon coast en route for San Francisco.
