DAYTON SWINDLER CAPTURED.

Beform School Boys Escape and Steel Two Horses—Great Northern Brakeman Run Over in Moses Coules.

PORTLAND, Oct. 80.—Mrs. C. A. Lombard, wife of a prominent young broker, committed suicide in her room at "The Hill," a family botel, this evening by shooting herself with a pistol. The couple had only been married a few months, but it is said they did not live happily together.

The suicide has created a protound sensation, as they were very prominent in society. Mrs. Lombard was a daughter of Caut. James Marshall, of Seattle, who committed suicide about a year ago by leaping into the Pacific ocean from a sceamer while off the Oregon coast on route for Sea Francisco.
