## **LOMBARD HORSES RUN AWAY**

**One Is Badly Injured, a Policeman  
Catches the Other, and People  
in Carriage Are Saved.**

There was great excitement in Dock square yesterday morning, caused by the runaway of the horses hitched to a private carriage owned by Benjamin Lombard, Jr., of 1566 Beacon street, Brookline, and driven by John Owens. The horses took fright at a car in Adams square. Near Union street the horses collided with another vehicle, injuring one of the horses. As the horse fell his mate reared, and just then Night Officer Kennefick of headquarters sprang for the bridle and finally subdued the frenzied animal. Meanwhile citizens assisted a thoroughly frightened elderly lady and young woman to alight from the carriage, uninjured. The injured horse had to be killed.
