Arch Lumbard

- Etna, March 1—Arch Lumbard, 77, died Thursday, Feb. 23, at his home at Etna after a ten-days illness. He was the son of James Lumbard and a descendant of pioneers of this community. His first wife was Edith Tichenor, by whom he had two children, Laverne Lumbard of Etna and Mrs. Laverne Cotech of Groton, who survive him. After the death of Mrs. Edith Lumbard, he married Mrs. Carrie Brotherton Van Marter, who survives him. His mother, Mrs. Jeannette Lumbard of Ithaca, two sisters, Mrs. John Parkin of Ithaca and Mrs. Frank Vanfine of the Brick district, and one brother, Jay Lumbard of the Washington District, and four grandchildren were also living at the time of his death, but his mother at the age of 93, died Wednesday morning, March 1, at her home in Ithaca.

Mr. Lumbard's funeral was held at his home Sunday afternoon. Dr. Hermon P. Williams, pastor of the Etna church and the Rev. Anson H. Bell, former pastor, officiating. The funeral was largely attended, relatives being present from Elmira, Waverly and Geneva. The body was placed in the vault at Willow Glen
