Mrs. Frank E. Scott

Mrs. Frank E. Scott, age 77, of 428 Madison street, died Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at St. Michael's hospital, following an illness of three years. She was confined to bed part of that time and entered the hospital Saturday evening.

A native of Portage county, Mrs. Scott, whose maiden name was Clara M. Lombard, was born in the Lanark vicinity on June 2, 1876, a daughter of Halbert and Henrietta Lombard. She spent her early life at her parents' home and taught in the rural schools of Portage county. Her marriage to Mr. Scott took place at Amherst on April 2, 1891. The couple resided at Amherst, Eau Claire, Bloomer, Madison, Mauston, St. Paul, Dickinson, N. D., New Richmond and Marshfield before locating in Stevens Point 12 years ago. Mr. Scott was engaged in the real estate business before coming to Stevens Point and after moving here he operated the bulk plant of the Stevens Point Oil company. He retired in August, 1941.

Surviving are her husband, two sons, Leland W. Scott and George B. Scott, and two grandchildren, Lieutenant Donald J. Scott, who is a pilot on a Liberator bomber in the South Pacific, and Sally Ann Scott.

Mrs. Scott was a member of the Royal Neighbors of America.

Funeral services will be held Thursday morning at 10 o'clock at the Boston funeral home where the body may be viewed this evening from 7 to 9 o'clock. The body will be taken to Minneapolis where burial will take place Friday morning in Acacia Memorial park. Her husband, her son and daughter-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Leland Scott of Minneapolis, and Mrs. Alice Meusing of St. Paul will accompany the remains to Minneapolis.
