

WHO ENTERED CONSTABLE'S ROOM.

WILL PROBABLY DIE.

Roswell Lombard Run Over by a Buggy on Howard Street.

Roswell Lombard, an elderly man, residing at 646 Folsom street, was run over by a buggy driven by two men about 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon on the corner of Eleventh and Howard streets and received injuries that will almost certainly result in his death. He was removed to the Receiving Hospital, where an examination proved that the base of his skull was fractured. The operation of trepanning was performed by the Police Surgeon. Lombard was also bruised and cut on the body and legs. The men who were in the buggy are believed to have attended a funeral that took place from a house on Howard street, near Twelfth, as one of them carried a large bouquet.

After running over Lombard they put the whip to the horse and drove rapidly away. A description of the men was obtained from some boys who saw the occurrence, and officers were at once detailed to search for them.
