

MRS. SARAH LUMBARD DEAD

**Well Known Fremont Woman
Passed Away Early Sunday**

Mrs. Sarah J. Lumbard, after a lingering illness of several months, passed peacefully away at 7:30 Sunday morning at the home of her son, D. A. Lumbard. Death was due to old age and resulting complications. Funeral services will be held tomorrow at the residence at 10 a. m., Rev. Thomas Bitbell, pastor of the First Methodist church, officiating.

Mrs. Lumbard was a woman of beautiful Christian character and exceptionally keen intellect. During her residence in Fremont since 1868 she was until her health failed a few years ago, prominent in all the affairs of the Methodist church. From early girlhood she had been a student and reader.

Two sons survive her, D. A. Lumbard of Fremont and P. E. Lumbard of Red Lodge, Mont. The latter will not be able to come to attend the funeral.

The deceased was born January 14, 1831, in Oneida county, N. Y. Her maiden name was Sturdevant, coming from sturdy Huguenot stock which left its impress on her character.

She came to Fremont in 1868 with her husband, George W. Lumbard, who died a short time ago. Until a few years ago they resided on a farm north of Fremont.
